It must be acknowledged that the year presented financial challenges for the school; we have had to operate carefully within tight budgetary constraints due to the current economic climate and ongoing funding cuts over recent years. Despite this, we successfully managed our provision to ensure that pupils continued to receive the very best experiences. In this regard, I must thank you, the parents, for your vital contributions through the Parent-Teacher Association; the fundraising spirit has long been a strength of the school community in supporting the life of Ysgol Pant Pastynog—thank you all for your generosity. We are also grateful for the grants received during the year. Above all, we extend our sincere thanks to Mr Meirion Edwards for his diligent and skilled leadership of the school, and for maintaining such close, constant oversight of the budget—no small task. Mae plant Ysgol Pant Pastynog yn derbyn addysg o ansawdd uchel. Prif nod ein Cwricwlwm yw helpu plant i gyflawni'r 4 diben sef, bod yn -

- Ddysgwyr uchelgeisiol a galluog,
- Dysgwyr mentrus a chreadigol,
- Dinasyddion egwyddorol a gwybodus
- Dysgwyr iach a hyderus.

Er mwyn i'r plant gyrraedd y 4 diben rydym yn addysgu'r 6 Maes dysgu a Phrofiad sef:

1. **Celfyddydau Mynegiannol** - Celf, Dawns, Ffilm, Drama, Cerddoriaeth a Chyfryngau Digidol
2. **Iechyd a Llesiant** - Dysgu am gael corff a meddwl iach, deall perthnasoedd iach a sut i wneud penderfyniadau bywyd da.
3. **Dyniaethau** - Dysgu am hanes, daearyddiaeth a chrefyddau. A hefyd busnes, gwleidyddiaeth
4. **Ieithoedd, Llythrennedd a chyfathrebu** - Dysgu a deall sut i gyfathrebu mewn gwahanol ieithoedd (llafar, darllen ac ysgrifennu.)
5. **Mathemateg a Rhifedd** - Dysgu sgiliau rhif, trin data, siâp a chyfrifo.
6. **Gwyddoniaeth a Thechnoleg** - Deall natur a phethau byw, sut mae pethau yn gweithio, dylunio ac adeiladu pethau.

Ynglwm i'r hyn a ddysgir drwy'r Meysydd Dysgu mae'r plant hefyd wedi bod yn dysgu sgiliau llythrennedd, rhif a digidol yn drawsgwricwlaidd.

Yn y Cyfnod Sylfaen, mae'r disgyblion yn parhau i gael gwersi Cymraeg a Mathemateg bob bore ac yna bob prynhawn rhown gyfleoedd i'r plant ddysgu drwy chwarae yn y gwahanol ardaloedd dysgu: ardal iaith, ymchwiliol, rhif, adeiladu, byd bach, yr ardal dawel, sain, dwylo prysur, graffeg, TGCh, rhyngweithiol, iach a thu allan.

The Pupils at Ysgol Pant Pastynog receive education of a good standard. The main aim of our Curriculum is to ensure that the children become -

- *Ambitious, capable learners*
- *Enterprising, creative contributors*
- *Ethical, informed citizens*
- *Healthy, confident individuals*

In order for the children to achieve the 4 purposes we teach the 6 Areas of learning and Experience which are:

1. **Expressive Arts** - Art, Dance, Film, Drama, Music and Digital Media
2. **Health and Wellbeing** - Learning about having a healthy body and mind, understanding healthy relationships and how to make good life decisions.

3. **Humanities** - Learning about history, geography and religions. And also business, politics
4. **Languages, Literacy and communication** - Learning to communicate (speaking, writing and understanding different languages).
5. **Mathematics and Numeracy** - Learning number skills, data manipulation, shape and calculation.
6. **Science and Technology** - Understanding nature and living things, how things work, designing and building things.

In addition to what is taught through the 6 Areas of Learning, the children have also been learning literacy, number and digital skills cross-curricular.

In the Foundation Stage, the children have Welsh and Maths lessons each morning and every afternoon we give them opportunities to learn through play in the various learning areas: language, investigative, number, building, small world, quiet area, sound, busy hands, graphic, ICT, interactive, healthy and outside.

Addysg Bersonol a Chymdeithasol – Personal and Social Education

Mae ABaCh yn helpu plant i ddatblygu'n bobl gyfrifol a hunan hyderus ac mae agweddau o ABaCh yn gwau drwy holl bynciau'r cwricwlwm drwy'r ysgol. Anogwn ein plant i chwarae rôl bositif wrth gyfrannu at fywyd yr ysgol a'r gymdeithas ehangach. Rhoddir cyfle i'r plant gael llais a chlust o fewn y sesiynau Amser Cylch yn y dosbarthiadau.

PSE helps the children to develop into confident and responsible individuals and aspects of PSE interweave through all subjects throughout the school. We encourage children to play a positive role by contributing to the life of the school and to that of the wider world. The children are given a voice and an ear in the Circle Time within the classes.

Cyngor Ysgol - School Council (Pwyllgor Sam Committee)

Llwyddodd y Cyngor Ysgol i drefnu a chodi arian ar gyfer Diwrnod Plant Mewn Angen. Yn ogystal bu iddynt ysgrifennu llythyr i'r Sir yn gofyn am gymorth er mwyn lleihau costau biliau ynni. Yn dilyn hyn, bu i Sir osod paneli Solar ar do'r Ysgol, gwyliau hanner tymor yr Hydref. Penderfynodd y pwyllgor mai casglu arian tuag at Ambiwllans Awyr Cymru ac Ysbyty Alder Hey oedden ni am ei wneud eleni yn dilyn ein gwasanaethau. Maent hefyd wedi hel syniadau gan blant yr ysgol ar sut i ddatblygu'r ysgol. Yn ogystal bu i Swyddogion y Pwyllgor gyflwyno gwaith Pwyllgorau'r Ysgol yn Fforwm Cyngorau Ysgol Sir Ddinbych.

Cafodd y pwyllgorau eraill yn yr ysgol hefyd gyfle i arwain gweithgareddau'r ysgol yn ystod y flwyddyn; er enghraifft, cynhaliodd Pwyllgor Greta fore coffi ar gyfer elusen Cancr Macmillan, trefnodd Pwyllgor Iori ddiwrnod pop corn a siocled poeth i godi arian i brynu offer Addysg Gorfforol newydd, a chynhaliodd Pwyllgor Cai fore coffi cymunedol ar gyfer yr elusen Cymorth Gristnogol.

The School Council successfully organised and raised funds for Children in Need. In addition, they wrote a letter to the County asking for assistance to reduce our energy costs. Following this, the County installed solar panels on the school roof during the Autumn half-term holiday. Following our services, they decided to collect money for the Wales Air Ambulance and Alder Hey Hospital. They have also been gathering ideas from the pupils on how to develop the school. Furthermore, the Committee Officers presented the work of all of our school committees at the Denbighshire School Councils Forum.

The Other committees at school, also had the opportunity to lead some School's activities during the year; for example, Greta's Committee held a coffee morning for Macmillan Cancer Support, Iori's Committee arranged a popcorn and hot chocolate day to raise funds to buy new PE equipment, and Cai's Committee held a community coffee morning for the Christian Aid Charity.

Bydd Mr Neil Roberts ein Hymwelydd Esgob yn cynnal gwasanaethau yn dymhorol ac rydym yn ffodus iawn o gael criw 'Troi'r Tudalen' yn dod draw bob hanner tymor i rannu a pherfformio straeon o'r Beibl.

Rydym hefyd eleni wedi sefydlu partneriaeth gyda Chapel Llanrhaeadr fel rhan o Bontio'r Cenhedlau. Cafodd plant CA2 gyfle i ymgynnull yn fisol yng Nghapel Llanrhaeadr i sgwrsio a chanu gyda thrigolion yr ardal. Cafwyd hefyd gyfle i fynd i gyd-ganu gyda chleifion yn Ysbyty Dinbych. Cafodd y gymuned gyfle i ddod draw i'r Ysgol i gynnal gweithdy cerddorol gyda phlant a chymuned yr Ysgol. Mae'r plant wedi elwa'n fawr wrth fod yn rhan o'r prosiect a hyderwn y cawn gyfle i fod yn rhan o brosiect tebyg eto blwyddyn nesaf.

Being part of the community is very important to us as a school. Foundation Phase classes have enjoyed being able to use the 'Vicarage' garden, to hold lessons outside and have a teddy picnic. Several members of the community have visited the school to help with the children—whether to help with gardening, running activities, or coming in weekly to listen to some of the children read. We have once again taken part in the St David's Day parade in Denbigh, and we take pride in seeing our children show such pride in their culture. We have made use of Llanrhaeadr Church to host our Thanksgiving Service and Saron Chapel holding our mock baptism service.

Cylch Meithrin and Clwb Sêr continue to be extremely valuable clubs for the school and the local community. Also 'Ti a fi' is held every Friday morning between 10 and 11:30 in the Parish Cabin, which is another opportunity for prospective parents to come over for a cup of tea and a chat, and to get a taste and feel of the school.

The community has been making regular use of the school's minibus. We are extremely fortunate to have a community that is very supportive of the school.

We also have a close link with the Diocese, with Reverend Juliet Fraser and Reverend Andras Iago/Sarah Dafydd regularly conducting services at our school. Mr Neil Roberts, our Bishop Visitor, leads termly services, and we are very fortunate to have 'Turn the Page' group, who visit every half-term, to share and perform different Bible stories.

*This year, we also established a partnership with Llanrhaeadr Chapel as part of the *Pontio'r Cenhedlau* (Bridging the Generations) initiative. Key Stage 2 pupils had the opportunity to gather monthly at Llanrhaeadr Chapel to socialise and sing with local residents. There was also an opportunity to join patients at Denbigh Infirmary for a singing session. Members of the community were invited to the school to hold a music workshop with the pupils and the school community. The children have benefited greatly from being*

part of this project, and we hope to have the opportunity to participate in a similar project again next year.

Darpariaeth ar gyfer plant ag Anableddau neu Anghenion Dysgu Ychwanegol /

Provision for children with Disabilities or Additional Educational Needs

Nod yr ysgol ydi datblygu pob disgybl hyd at eithaf ei allu ac mae darpariaeth ar gael i gynorthwyo'r disgyblion i wneud hynny. Mae Mrs Jan Roberts wedi bod yn dod i mewn i wneud gwaith cefnogi gwirfoddol yn rheolaidd, ac rydym hefyd yn targedu plant pan fo angen.

Nodir ym mholisi ADY yr ysgol y drefn o adnabod, asesu a darparu ar gyfer disgyblion ag ADY. Y pennaeth a Senco'r Clwstwr sef Manon Tudur sy'n gyfrifol am gydlynw'r ddarpariaeth briodol ac mae aelod o'r Corff Llywodraethol hefyd wedi'i dewis i fonitro'r polisi.

Cynhelir cyfarfodydd Cynllunio gyda'r Awdurdod Addysg yn ystod y flwyddyn er mwyn sicrhau'r ddarpariaeth orau i'n plant. Mae hyn yn cynnwys cyfarfodydd efo'r Seicolegydd Addysg, y Gwasanaeth Cefnogi Ymddygiad, Iaith a Lleferydd ac asiantaethau arbenigol eraill. Yn ogystal â hyn, mae ysgolion Clwstwr Glan Clwyd yn cwrdd yn rheolaidd i drafod materion ADY.

Yn ystod y flwyddyn, buddsoddwyd mewn hyfforddiant ac adnoddau er mwyn i ni allu ymateb i anghenion ein dysgwyr - hyfforddiant i gefnogi Llythrennedd a rhifedd.

The aim of the school is to develop each pupil to the maximum of their ability and provision is available to help the pupils to do that. Mrs Jan Roberts has been coming in to do voluntary support work regularly, and we also target children when necessary.

The school's ALN policy states the procedure for identifying, assessing and providing for pupils with ALN. The headteacher and Cluster Head, Manon Tudur, are responsible for coordinating the appropriate provision and a member of the Governing Body has also been chosen to monitor the policy.

Planning meetings are held with the Education Authority during the year to ensure the best provision for our children. This includes meetings with the Educational Psychologist, the Behaviour, Language and Speech Support Service and other specialist agencies. In addition to this, Glan Clwyd Cluster schools meet regularly to discuss ALN issues.

During the year, we invested in training and resources so that we could respond to the needs of our learners - training to support Literacy and numeracy.
